## Terms and Conditions for 'Quilts in Cae Hir Gardens' 2017

There will be NO THEME in 2017.

You may enter as many quilts as you like. Please fill out a new entry form for each exhibit. All entries must be constructed by hand or machine. You may use any fabrics or techniques, but the quilt should constitute three layers of a textile sandwich.

All quilts to have a hanging sleeve.

The finished item can be either a bed quilt or wall hanging and can be made by an individual or a group. It can be traditional or contemporary. Work is to be of original design, or if the design is taken from a book/magazine then this must be acknowledged. Maker's and/or longarm quilter's names should also be acknowledged.

Maximum drop when hanging is 7ft. If your quilt is bigger please contact Cae Hir Gardens, as we have limited space to hang very large quilts.

**All quilts MUST be washable - whilst we will make every effort to keep quilts safe, this is an outdoor event and the weather cannot be guaranteed! Quilts may get wet, the wind could blow them down or get them caught in branches or a bird could do its business.**

Entry forms to arrive by 1st July 2017 accompanied by a non-returnable entry fee of £10.00 per quilt. If you would like to have your quilt posted back to you after the event, this will cost an extra £10.00 per quilt (overseas entries will be charged actual return postage). You are welcome to collect your quilt in person after the event to avoid this cost. NB: cheques now to be made payable to *J S Akkermans*.

You will be sent an official quilt number by post, no later than 25<sup>th</sup> July 2017, with details of how to send or deliver your quilt(s). You will also receive one free entry ticket to the garden per quilt entered.

Each quilt must come in its own cloth casing (a pillowcase is ideal). Your name must be on the casing. Maker or group's name must also be permanently attached to the quilt.

Quilts must arrive at Cae Hir Gardens by August 15<sup>th</sup> to give us time to organise suitable hanging positions. We reserve the right not to hang any quilts which arrive late.

Viewers' Choice ballots will determine winners. Prizes for 2017 yet to be confirmed. Prizes are not transferable and no cash alternatives can be offered. No responsibility is accepted for entry forms or quilts lost, damaged or delayed in the post. Acceptance of an entry assumes the grant of permission by the maker for the quilt to be photographed.

PLEASE BE AWARE: If it rains your quilt will get wet – we no longer hang quilts in plastic bags. Some exhibitors spray their quilts with *Scotchguard* water repellent as a precaution, with positive feedback. If you do this we advise you spray scrap fabrics as a test before spraying the whole quilt.

**Quilts are entered entirely at your own risk and we accept no responsibility for quilts getting wet or damaged while hanging outside. Quilts will be brought in overnight.**

### **DATES FOR YOUR DIARY in 2017**

**1st July:** Closing date for entries – entry forms and fee to be sent to Cae Hir by this date.

**25<sup>th</sup> July:** You will receive your confirmation letter, entry pass and quilt label(s) by this date.

**15<sup>th</sup> August:** Quilts to arrive at Cae Hir Gardens by this date.

**25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> August:** The Exhibition is on!
